

Lifeline / Link-up Program



Lifeline and Link-up are two Wisconsin Universal Service Fund programs that make essential telecommunications more affordable for low-income households. Lifeline reduces monthly telephone charges and Link-Up waives telephone connection charges for income eligible households. To be eligible for assistance in these plans, an applicant must participate in one of the following programs:

- Wisconsin Works (W2)
- Medical Assistance (MA)
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Food Stamps
- Low Income Housing Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)
- WI Homestead Tax Credit (Schedule H)
- Badger Care

To apply contact Price County Telephone Company

The application form requires your social security number, signature and a copy of your benefit card (for all programs other than Food Stamps). Once your eligibility is verified, a credit will appear on your monthly telephone bill.
